Just needs to clean up her game and not try to do too much at times and commit the turnovers (had 8 in this game). Uses good body fakes and stop and go moves to keep her defense off-balance and penetrate to the basket. February 6 (SeminoleStateCollege-OK) ...STARTER. Through 19 games is averaging 11.4 ppg and has hit 36% from three. Also getting 4.8 rebounds and dishing out 6 assists per game. Handles it well but has some clever moves to escape pressure. March 25-April 1 DI-NationalTournament (WallaceStateCommunityCollege-AL) ...STARTER. January 18 (NorthernOklahomaCollege-Tonkawa) ... STARTER... Strength is good and has the ability to go up through her defender to get her shot off inside. Uses the board pretty effectively. Has good hands. Could project higher if she can become a better shooter from mid-range. Floor speed is good. Had strong game with 16 points and 14 rebounds. STARTER... January 1 (EasternOklahomaStateCollege) ... Has the ability to go up and shoot over taller defenders on the low block, but needs to develop better moves to make defenders move to free herself up and put herself in a better position to finish. Mid-range game needs to improve as the majority of her scoring is in the paint and off the low block.</b>

Put on the floor from the perimeter and took it to the rim with very good quickness. Will get the defensive rebound and bust out of the pack and push the break. After pulling down the offensive board needs to jump quicker and go right back up before taller defenders can react.
